

Refuse Removal / Recycling

There are bin sheds located around Gort na Coiribe in the following locations:

Behind Apts. 12 & 13	Number 1
Behind Apts. 24 & 25	Number 2
Beside No 93	Number 3
Beside No. 119	Number 4
Beside No. 108	Number 5
Beside No. 136	Number 6

Numbers 3,4,5 & 6 are locked. The 1st person to check in from the house will be issued the bin shed key. 1 & 2 will be locked soon, we will issue keys then.

We suggest you keep this in one agreed location e.g., by microwave, or on fire mantle so it is accessible to all. There is a €20 replacement key charge if lost or not handed back at the end of the year. This is chargeable to all tenants.

Each shed contains a large red bin for general waste, a large green bin for clean and dry recycling and the larger bin shed contains 3 small glass bins for clear, brown & green glass.

Each unit is provided with two bins to allow for easier segregation of rubbish. Please consider the environment when disposing of your rubbish and recycle as much as possible.

Glass Recycling

Glass must be separated by colour – green, brown and clear – and put into the corresponding glass bin.

Clean & Dry Recycling (large green bin)

The following items may be placed in this bin:

- Junk Mail
- Magazines
- Cardboard
- Newspaper
- Plastic Bottles
- Drink Cans
- Food Tins
- Tetra Pak

Please ensure that all items are **clean** and **dry** before placing them in the bin.

General Waste (large red bin)

Any non-recyclable waste or food waste that does not fit into the above categories should go into this bin for disposal. Examples of non-recyclable waste include nappies, dirty plastic, tin foil, bathroom bin sanitary items, blades, toothpaste tubes, non-CFL light bulbs, crisp packets, biscuit wrappers, and wax-paper wrappings.

The bins are emptied 3 times a week.
